

How to Play \$10,000 OSU-UM Football Pool:

1. There are two separate football pools that differ by the price per square.
Gold bracket: \$100 per square with payout of \$5,000
Silver bracket: \$20 per square with a payout of \$1,000
2. Dollar amount per squares are dependent on the price per square and the payout per quarter to be awarded. The payout for each pool will be awarded at the end of the game and will be paid for EACH QUARTER as follows:

GOLD Bracket: \$100 per square, \$5000 payout

First quarter score: \$500

Second quarter (halftime): \$500

Third quarter: \$500

Fourth quarter (final): \$3,500

SILVER Bracket: \$20 square, \$1000 payout

First quarter score: \$100

Second quarter (halftime): \$100

Third quarter: \$100

Fourth quarter (final): \$700

3. Individuals will be able to purchase square(s) and be assigned a unique number for the pool.
4. Purchasers will have the option of purchasing their square(s) online through the Loveland Legacy Foundation website event page or in person at Ramsay's Trailside in Loveland.
5. Purchases made through the website will have their square assignments randomly selected by the LLF board staff.
6. Purchases made in person at Ramsay's Trailside will provide the option of selecting a specific square from the pool boards on display at the restaurant by the designated staff person.
7. Once all the squares are filled up or no later than 11:45 am on November 30, 2019. The team names and score numbers will be randomly selected and the pool board will be updated.

Draw the names first to determine what team name to place vertically on the grid and which team is horizontal.

Draw the numbers one by one place writing each number drawn over each horizontal column and draw again for the vertical rows side. (there should only be one number, including the zeros, that correspond with the horizontal columns and vertical rows, think x/y axis from math class)

8. Winners for each quarter will be the last number in the single digit score for each team at the end of that specific quarter. The amounts will be according the payout schedule listed above and monies will be awarded at the end of the game.

For example, at the end of the first quarter, the game is 14-7. The person who has number 4 (for that corresponding team) and who has 7 (for that corresponding team) are the winners for that quarter.
